[The National Framework to Deliver Improved Outcomes in All-Age Autism Assessment Pathways](#) sets out the general principles to be applied to the autism assessment pathway, to improve outcomes, and how the commissioning cycle can be used to deliver autism assessment pathways. This document is aimed at people working in health commissioning roles, and lead clinicians in NHS and independent sector community and inpatient service providers.

[The Operational Guidance to Deliver Improved Outcomes in All-Age Autism Assessment Pathways](#) sets out information about how an autism assessment pathway is configured and delivered to produce good clinical outcomes. The Hewitt Review: An independent review of Integrated Care Systems

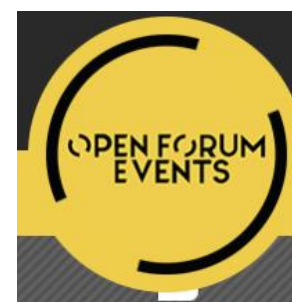
The Rt Hon Patricia Hewitt was commissioned to lead an independent review of integrated care systems in November. Please find the published report [here](#).
